Frank Portolese has been active in the Chicago area as a performer and educator for over 25 years. He has performed throughout the US, the UK and Europe. His performing credits include work with Eddie Harris, Les McCann, Shelley Manne, Ira Sullivan, Catherine Russell, Claude "Fiddler" Williams, Bobby Shew and many others. His pop performing credits range from Sammy Davis, Jr. to Clay Aiken. Portolese's debut CD, *Transparent*, is on the Southport label and was released in 1994. His second release, *Last Call*, was released in 2000. His newest CD is *Plectrum Jazz Guitar Solos* (2010).

Mr. Portolese founded the Jazz Program for Midwest Young Artists, a youth music organization located at Fort Sheridan, IL. He currently teaches at the University of Michigan and at Elmhurst College. He has also taught for the American Conservatory of Music in Chicago and the Jamey Aebersold Summer Jazz Camp. He has done clinics and master classes throughout the Midwest and in the U.K.
